He faithfully keeps His promises.

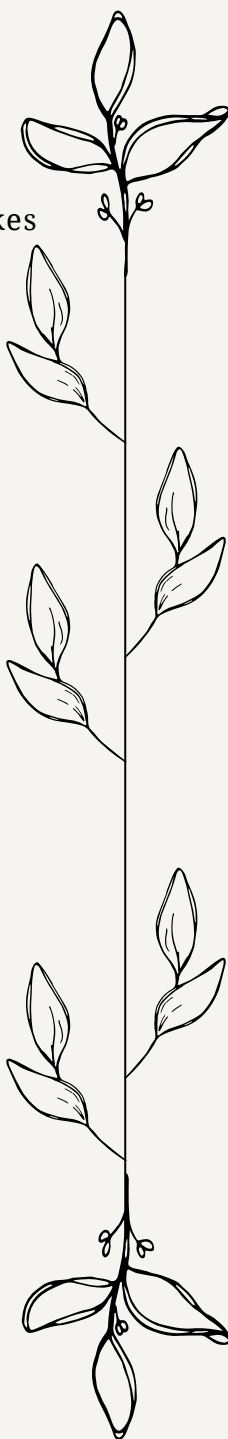
In a biblical worldview, doing things God's way instead of my own way is what defines a good life.

Jesus' divinity makes Him the perfect, unblemished, holy sacrifice required to pay the price of sin.

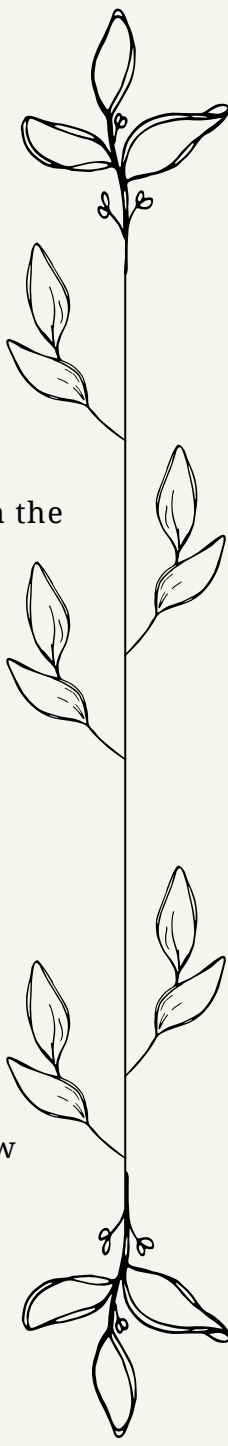
Jesus' humanity allows Him to die on the cross for our sins.

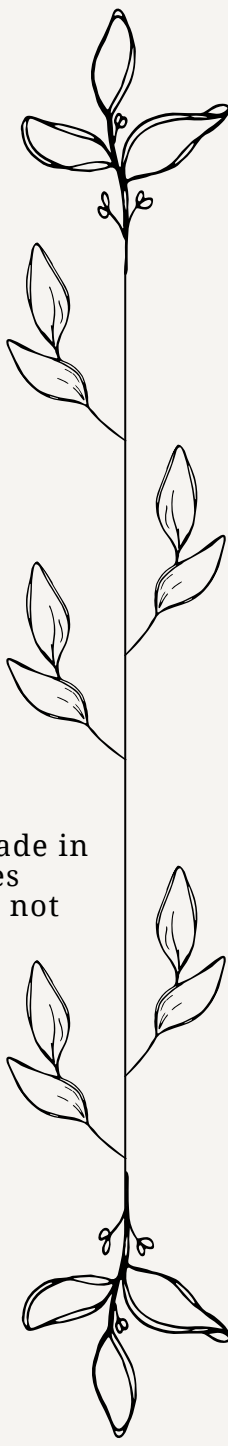
KNOWLEDGE

I can be shaped by God's Word and the people of God, instead of by entertainment.

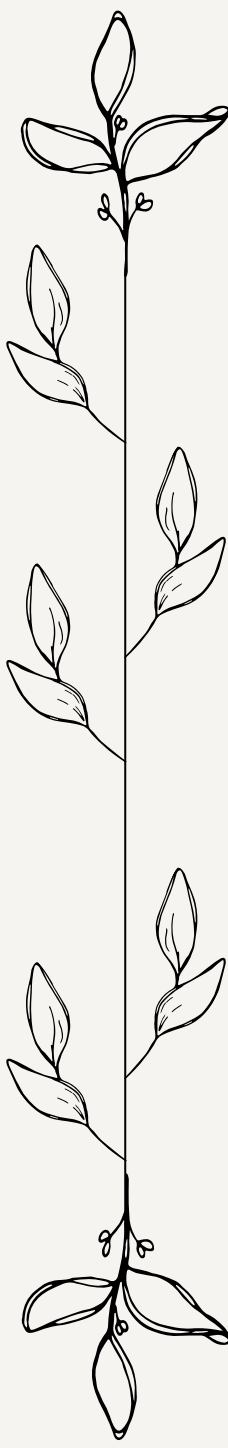
