8-2-20 Family Discussion Questions **DON'T LOSE HEART** 2 Corinthians 4:7-18

1. Read 2 Corinthians 4:7. The Apostle Paul is teaching us that we are jars of clay that hold a precious treasure - the

gospel. Why did God allows plain jars of clay to hold a treasure like the gospel?

[God wants us to hold the treasure of the gospel so that we can show that power comes from God, not us. We can do extraordinary things for God.]

2. What plans did you have this summer that were changed or canceled?

[Talk to your kids about the dreams and plan they had for the summer, or even for the next school year. Maybe share how your dreams and plans have been changed by God in the past. Encourage them with the truth from 2 Corinthians 4:7-18 - we experience these disappointments so that we want God more than our plans, and that we would focus on eternal things more than the temporary things in life.]
